The final clinic of the 2014 Marathon Campaign was smoothly completed on Saturday, 8 February 2014 at WYK. Over 100 runners have attended the event. After the training session, the runners put on their new team tees and performed a round-campus run as a warm up exercise.

The Wah Yan One Family Marathon Team is the only secondary school team (total 520 runners) among the 10 winners which was awarded the “Most Supportive Group Award”. This is an acknowledgement for the selfless efforts of all the runners and partners who have joined WYOFF to run and raise funds over the years to support sports development in the two Schools.

The Wah Yan One Family Marathon Team will take part in the 10 km Run 2, starting at 06:30 a.m. on Sunday, 16 February 2014.

The fundraising target of WYOFF this year is HK\$1 million. Up to now, WYOFF has only raised HK\$500,000 – HK\$600,000 thus far. The funding is vital for the continuation of provision of professional training to all students and school team members of both Wah Yans. Since 2008, WYOFF has raised over HK\$6 million for this specific purpose.
