THE PERSON of CONSCIENCE

- The person of conscience will feel called to look at the world, at reality, with the eyes of God; to discover the goodness and beauty of creation and individuals but also places of pain, misery and injustice.

THE COMPETENT PERSON

The competent person as someone who is “capable of creating, understanding and using knowledge and skills to live in his/her own context and transform it; being competent means being able to work and flourish with others
