## **Obituary**

### **A man in grace**

A grace it must be for Stephen Choy 蔡致中 to ascent from Diocesan Boys' School Primary Division to WYK in 1979. Wearing a smiling face, a joyful character, always being unpretentious, a shade of shy – he was the first-former to grow and develop his love of God and others in the College of the Sacred Heart in Kowloon.

Stephen was a gifted singer, pianist, and an all-rounded musician. Classical works, oldies, Cantopop – he loved all. We both played the cello part of our School Hymn which was the debut performance by our first string orchestra in 1983. He was the leader of our English Debate Team, and a committee member of the Joint School English Debating Society. He was destined to be a friend of mine for a lifetime.

Stephen commenced his studies in medicine in the University of Hong Kong in 1986. He strived to understand, and questioned every clinical sign. Memorising lists of unrelated items, which was my pastime, was not quite agreeable to him. But then, medicine was meant to be dry in that stage of learning. A medical student's academia was bound to be mediocre if he insisted to understand the underlying mechanisms before committing anything into synapses between his grey cells.

There has only been one examination in an open-book modality – immunology. Without having to memorise unconnected pieces of knowledge, this man shined, and attained the highest score in his class of merely 150 students.

Stephen is a devout Catholic. He served as the Treasurer of the Catholic Society (Katso) of the University of Hong Kong for two terms, in 1986-87 and 1987-88. The friendship of Stephen and I brewed into full maturity then. Two men also found their dream girls concomitantly.

Once jumped out from the crate of medical school, Dr Choy could finally learn by his hands. His might flourished. He became a Member of the Royal Colleges of Physicians in the United Kingdom, a Fellow of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine in internal medicine, and a Fellow of the Hong Kong College of Cardiology.

Dr Choy was a cardiologist in Princess Margaret Hospital, where he has been serving the public unceasingly for 25 years. His expertises were transthoracic and transoesophageal echocardiography. He was versatile in numerous percutaneous transluminal cardiac procedures and pacing.

Beyond the bounds of the hospital, Dr Choy was a servant of the community. He contributed actively to the educational programs of the Hong Kong College of Cardiology. He also assisted in running self-help groups for patients with heart diseases and their families.

Dr Choy took leave temporarily in peace on 24 June 2018. He is survived by his faith, and by his wife, his daughter and son. He has joined the majority. We shall all join him. Until then, he will be fondly remembered by his beloved ones, physicians whom he trained, and patients whom he healed. He remains being – a man in grace.
